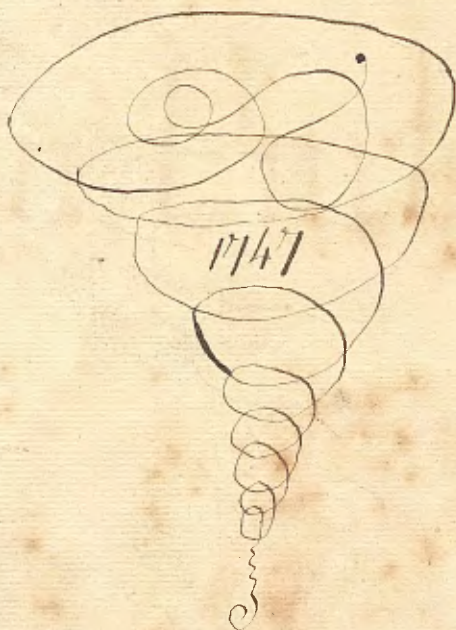

3. That if any Member or Members of this Society shall not be at the place appointed for the Monthly Peal precisely at Four o'Clock, he or they shall forfeit two pence if he or they come not at all, Four pence....)

4. That if any Member or Members of this Society shall not be at the place appointed for the quarterly Peal precisely at three o'Clock, he or they shall forfeit 3<sup>s</sup> 6<sup>d</sup> if he or they come not at all.....)
